ERBEYLİ PRIMARY SCHOOL

The initial construction of Erbeyli Primary School dates back to the early republican period, and it is estimated to have been built in 1927, according to official records. Due to the location of the school, the students of such neighbourhood villages as Sınırteke, Akçeşme, Hamitler and also some other mountainuous villages' students and the students of Ömerbeyli village, attending the 4th and the 5th grades, have continued on their education in this school. Over time, the other villages got their own schools, the school has been a server to its own village.

Having been built in cooperation with state and citizens, Erbeyli Primary School was opened for education and training on October 14, in 1992. The School has been built as double storey of 430 m2 in a 3935 area m2, and there are 10 classrooms and 4 administrative buildings. The School has principal, vice principals, 5 primary school teacher, 1 pre-school teacher, 8 branch teachers and a paid teacher. By beginning of 2004-2005 academic year, a kindergarten was opened. Due to the lack of building, workshops and science laboratories and kindergarten operate in separate buildings. After switching to the 4+4 education system, our school has been serving as both Erbeyli Primary School and Erbeyli Secondary School.

The school is in the scope of bussed system, the 1st and the 2nd level of the students of Akçeşme, Arzular and Hamitler villages, and the 2nd level of the students of Eğrek and İsafakılar villages have been receiving education. 89 students have been attending within bussed context, and the total number of students coming to school is183.
